The Cabin (The Log Cabin Literary Center) incorporated as a nonprofit organization in 1996, and annually serves about 750 members, more than 2,000 children and youth, and more than 20,000 people with educational and cultural programs. Programs for young people are the largest part of The Cabin's work.

The Cabin has transitioned from a young literary organization to being a cultural anchor in Idaho, with programs that include:

- READINGS & CONVERSATIONS, an annual lecture series bringing internationally-acclaimed literary figures to Boise.
- WRITERS IN THE SCHOOLS (WITS), placing professional writers in classrooms and community settings.
- IDAHO WRITING CAMPS, one of ten model literary arts education programs in the U.S.
- THE IDAHO WRITERS GUILD, a community of professional writers helping writers.
- Literary activities such as writing workshops, readings by Idaho authors, and other programs for readers and writers of all ages.
